They visited the field, met some of the clients to understand about the impact of the Financial Education (FE) module that was one of the modules being carried out in the field for spreading financial education among clients. During the month of September, the SPM & PE team in coordination with Field Officers were able to reach near about 700 clients to deliver the FE modules while showing short videos from their mobile phones.

The team HR visited the Prestige Institute of Management, Gwalior to recruit professionals to be inducted in different roles at Sambandh. They were able to select 28 youngsters, mostly for Operations and Credit roles.
